

**Important information for *Biology of Reproduction* Authors on Compliance with the
“Revised Policy on Enhancing Public Access to Archived Publications Resulting
from NIH-Funded Research”**

The National Institutes of Health (NIH) has published its “Enhanced Public Access Policy” with respect to scientific publications resulting from research supported in part or fully by NIH funds

(<http://grants.nih.gov/grants/guide/notice-files/NOT-OD-08-033.html>). The rule **requires** that, as of 7 April 2008, all investigators funded by the NIH must submit (or have submitted for them) an electronic version of their final, peer-reviewed manuscripts, upon acceptance for publication, to the National Library of Medicine’s PubMed Central (PMC). This must be made publicly available no later than 12 months after the official date of publication. Moreover, all papers derived from research supported by HHMI, UK MRC, or Wellcome Trust must also be deposited in the public archive required by the funding agency. *Biology of Reproduction* does not deposit manuscripts on behalf of authors; you must do this yourself. The version of your paper that you deposit must be the “Papers-in-Press” (PIP version), and you must deposit your paper at PMC independently of and at least one day after the journal publication of the PIP version. In order to be compliant with the *Biology of Reproduction* copyright policy, you must indicate that your paper can be released for public access in 12 months and must contain reference to its prior publication in *Biology of Reproduction*.
